O R D E R

The petitioner has been granted affiliation as well as recognition and was exempted from the Common Entrance Test. However, by an order dated 30.05.2018, this exemption was revoked which revocation, in turn, was struck down by the Division Bench of the High Court dated 31.07.2018. Respondent No.2, by a letter dated 02.08.2018, directed the petitioner to start admitting students only after August 9, 2018.

In our order dated 24.05.2018, it has been stated that 13.08.2018 will be the last date to complete admissions.

Given the peculiar facts of this case, we are of the view that a certain minimum period should be given to the petitioner to complete the admission process. Without acting as a precedent, we allow the petitioner two weeks from today in order to complete the admission process.

The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
